A MOTION ratifying the Executive action establishing a special fee for disposal of waste resulting from flooding.

MOTION NO.

WHEREAS, King County experienced an abnormal amount of rainfall during the month of November, 1990; and

WHEREAS, this rainfall resulted in significant flooding and damage to homes, property and facilities in King County; and

WHEREAS, disposal of waste material resulting from flooding will cause financial hardship for many property owners; and

WHEREAS, King County Code 10.22.050 allows the manager of the solid waste division to authorize an exception to the payment of disposal fees for users who are engaged in a community litter cleanup campaign provided that the King County council ratifies that action; and

WHEREAS, the community of King County will also benefit from cleanup of damage caused by flooding; and

WHEREAS, the manager of the solid waste division has authorized a reduced rate for disposal of cleanup material resulting from flood damage;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County: The King County council hereby ratifies the executive action taken by the manager of the solid waste division to reduce rates for disposal of cleanup material resulting from flood damage and limiting payment of fees to \$6.50 per load for disposal by noncommercial parties using private vehicles and to \$47.00 per load for noncommercial vehicles larger than pickup trucks for disposal of waste material caused by flooding at
