2 A MOTION declaring the existence of an emergency due to  
3 heavy rainfall, mudslides, and flooding conditions in  
4 King County, requiring immediate repair of county roads  
5 and other facilities, waiving the requirements for com-  
6 petitive bidding or formal solicitation and Minority and  
7 Women's Business Enterprises requirements for such  
8 repairs and ratifying and confirming the Local  
9 Proclamation of Emergency issued by the King County  
10 Executive on November 24, 1990.

11 WHEREAS, weather conditions consisting of heavy rainfall creating  
12 extensive flooding in King County caused extensive damage to county  
13 facilities; and

14 WHEREAS, persons and property have been and will be damaged unless fur-  
15 ther efforts are taken to reduce the threat to life and property; and

16 WHEREAS, such repair work to county roads and other facilities must  
17 begin immediately in order to minimize the risk of personal injury and prop-  
18 erty damage; and

19 WHEREAS, the ordinary requirements for formal competitive bidding of  
20 the construction contracts pursuant to RCW Ch. 36.32 and formal solicitation  
21 requirements for professional/technical service consultant contracts and the  
22 purchase of tangible personal property pursuant to KCC Ch. 4.16 and compli-  
23 ance with Minority and Women's Business Enterprises requirements pursuant to  
24 KCC Ch. 4.18 for such repairs must be waived in order to prevent delay in  
25 beginning such repair work; and

26 WHEREAS, the King County Executive issued a Local Proclamation of  
27 Emergency on November 24, 1990, pursuant to RCW Ch. 36.40.180, RCW Ch. 38.52  
28 and KCC Ch. 12.52, and attached hereto and by this reference made a part  
29 hereof, and the council acknowledges receipt of the local proclamation of  
30 emergency;

31 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

32 A. The King County Council declares that an emergency exists in King  
33 County whereby the public interest would suffer material injury if necessary  
repair work is delayed.

B. The ordinary requirements for competitive bidding of construction  
contracts pursuant to RCW Ch. 36.32 and formal solicitation requirements for  
professional/technical service consultant contracts and the purchase of tan-

1 gible personal property pursuant to KCC 4.16 for such repair work by the  
2 department of public works and the department of planning and community  
3 development, parks division, in order to prevent delay in beginning such  
4 repair work are hereby waived.

5 C. The ordinary Minority and Women's Business Enterprises require-  
6 ments pursuant to KCC 4.18 are hereby waived as to the individual project  
7 contracts, provided that compliance with Minority and Women's Business  
8 Enterprises requirements shall be met by the collective group of construc-  
9 tion contracts and by the collective group of consultant contracts, as  
10 required pursuant to this emergency declaration.

11 D. The King County council hereby ratifies and confirms the local  
12 proclamation of emergency pursuant to KCC 12.52.030(B)(12).
