A MOTION declaring the intention of the King County Council to dissolve Road Improvement District No. 115, Redondo Overhead Utility Undergrounding and setting a date for a public hearing.

WHEREAS, King County Ordinance No. 9037 created Road Improvement
District No. 115 for the purpose of converting overhead electric and communications facilities to underground under and along the following streets:
Redondo Beach Drive from 1st Avenue South to South 287th Place, South 287th
Place from Redondo Beach Drive to Sound View Drive, Sound View Drive (aka
4th Place South) from South 287th Place to South 287th Street, and

WHEREAS, the feasibility of the project existed with the coordination of the utility conversion construction with the construction of a waterline rehabilitation project being done by the Federal Way Water District, and

WHEREAS, the Federal Way Water District has completed the waterline rehabilitation project and completed the contractual agreement with the contractor, and

WHEREAS, costs of accomplishing the overhead utility conversion project by other means would now exceed the benefits received to a number of properties within the assessment boundary, and

WHEREAS, the department of public works conducted a property owner survey to determine support for continuing the overhead utility conversion project, and

WHEREAS, results from said survey indicate that property owners representing 35.2% of the lineal front footage and 29.2% of the assessment area are in favor of continuing the project, and

WHEREAS, property owners favoring the continuance of the road improvement district no longer constitute a majority of the lineal front footage nor the area within the assessment area;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

A. It is the intention of the council to dissolve a road improvement district in King County known and designated as "King County Road Improvement District No. 115" (hereinafter "RID 115"), and terminate the proceedings thereof.

B. It is the intention of the county council that any costs incurred to date for preliminary engineering and administration will be applied to any road improvement district created in the future for the conversion of overhead electric and communication facilities utilities to underground included within the limits of RID 115 to the extent such costs are for work which benefits such later improvements.

- C. All persons who wish to object to or to otherwise be heard on the dissolution of Road Improvement District No. 115, are hereby notified to appear and present their objections or testimony at an open public meeting of the King County Council to be held in Room 402 of the King County Courthouse, Seattle, Washington at 9:30 a.m. on the day of Lineary, 1991. At such time and place, the council intends to hear such objections and testimony and to act on the intentions set forth herein.
- D. The clerk of the council is hereby authorized and directed to give notice of said public hearing by publication and by mailing at the times and in the manner described in RCW 36.88.050 for publication of the resolution of intention to establish a road improvement district.
