A MOTION authorizing a change in the original scope to the Harborview Medical Project Long Range CIP based on the projections of patient population taken from current statistics.

WHEREAS, projections of patient population have increased for 1995 patient visits based on current statistics, and

WHEREAS, based on these projections, Kaplan, McLaughlin, Diaz and the Burlington Group, design architectural team for the Harborview Medical Project, is proposing a change to the project's original scope, and

WHEREAS, prior projections were based upon the Perkins and Will Masterplan Study in 1985 which were reviewed and updated by NBBJ architectural firm in 1986, and

WHEREAS, the change in the scope of the project will accommodate a revised 1995 patient population of sixty-three thousand visits to the emergency room and twelve thousand psychiatric emergency room visits along with the related additional supporting beds and ancillary services, and

WHEREAS, the Harborview Medical Center Board of Trustees has recommended a change in scope as essential to provide care for those patients central to the Mission of Harborview, and

WHEREAS, the revised scope of the project will be consistent with the budget by means of bid alternates developed during design;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The change in project scope for the Harborview Medical Center Long Range CIP as generally outlined in Attachment A is authorized as a necessary response to address the needs of the 1995 patient population as projected by current statistics.

1 The Project Director is hereby authorized to conduct further  
2 design work consistent with the intent of Attachment A scope  
3 changes and to also maintain consistency with the current  
4 budget by means of bid alternates developed during design until  
5 such time as funding is identified for these scope changes.
