3 A MOTION authorizing application by the
4 Department of Human Services for funds from
5 the Office of Substance Abuse Prevention
6 for a Community Partnership Program in King
7 County.

8 WHEREAS, the Drugs: Draw the Line! program in the
9 department of human services is a project administered on
10 behalf of the Human Services Roundtable for the purpose of
11 increasing the involvement of local county citizens in finding
12 solutions to drug and alcohol abuse in King County, and

13 WHEREAS, a broad community partnership coalition of
14 governmental, educational, law enforcement, housing, health,
15 and human service organizations has requested that Drugs: Draw
16 the Line! act on their behalf in seeking federal funds to
17 support a coordinated community partnership approach to
18 substance abuse reduction in King County, and

19 WHEREAS, funds are available from the federal Office of
20 Substance Abuse to support such a comprehensive community
21 partnership approach to substance abuse prevention and
22 reduction;


23 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

24 A. The director of the department of human services is
25 hereby authorized to make application for a Community
26 Partnership Program grant from the Office of Substance Abuse
27 Prevention in the amount of \$2,653,063 over five years to
28 support the activities of the Community Partnership Program in
29 King County as outlined in the attached application for funds.


1 B. In the event the grant application is accepted and funds
2 are awarded, the Executive is requested to submit with the
3 appropriations ordinance a plan for program oversight.
