MOTION NO. **8150**

1 A MOTION appointing members to the
2 Districting Committee, per Section
3 650.30.020 of the Charter.

4 WHEREAS, the Home Rule Charter, Section 650.30.020,
5 Districting Plan, enables the County to implement a districting
6 procedure, and

7 WHEREAS, the Charter provides that during January 1981, and
8 in each January every fifth year thereafter, the Council shall
9 appoint four persons to a five member Districting Committee, and

10 WHEREAS, Section 650.30.10 of the Charter further provides
11 that the boundaries of each district shall correspond as nearly
12 as practical with the boundaries of election precincts,
13 municipalities and census tracts and shall be drawn to produce
14 districts with compact and contiguous territory, composed of
15 economic and geographic units and approximately equal in
16 population.

17 WHEREAS, the Charter provides that the Council appoint two
18 persons representing each of the two major political parties, the
19 four persons to appoint a fifth person who shall serve as the
20 chairman of the Districting committee; and

21 WHEREAS, the redistricting process should be conducted in a
22 manner that ensures the public opportunity to follow the process
23 and further offers opportunities for public participation;

24 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

25 Per the provisions of the Home Rule Charter, Section
26 650.30.020, the following persons are hereby appointed to
27 represent the two major political parties on the district
28 committee:

29 Democratic Party: 1. Kurt Becker

30 2. Tom Hujar

31 Republican Party: 1. Jack Donohue

32 2. Sally Poliak

The Districting Committee is requested to conduct its business according to the standards of the Open Meeting Act and to conduct at least one public hearing before adopting the districting plan.
