3 prepare an ordinance condemning a portion of South 214th
4 Street.

5 WHEREAS, the residents and property owners of 4th Place
6 South between South 214th and 216th Streets have expressed
7 their concerns about the potential safety hazard and
8 inconvenience of having street access to their property
9 obstructed; and

10 WHEREAS, these residents have entreated with their neighbor
11 to allow street access to their property; and

12 WHEREAS, their resort to the courts has proven costly and
13 ineffective; and

14 WHEREAS, the County has an interest in addressing the
15 safety needs of its citizens;

16 NOW, THEREFORE BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

17 The King County executive is directed to prepare and
18 forward for council consideration an ordinance condemning South
19 214th Street from 4th Place South to 5th Place South.
