A MOTION authorizing the executive to make a grant application for funds in the approximate amount of \$107,000 to support the First Responder Defibrillation and Improved Quality Assurance Program, Grant File No. 107.

WHEREAS. The responsibilities of the emergency medical services division as provided for in the King County Code, Chapter 8.64, include improving emergency medical services, analyzing emergency medical service needs, and providing planning for emergency medical services, and

WHEREAS, approximately 800 patients per year in King County experience prehospital sudden cardiac death, and

WHEREAS, early defibrillation (electric shocks delivered to overcome ineffective heart rhythms) by emergency medical personnel has been shown to be the single most effective means of improving both patient survival from prehospital sudden cardiac death and the post-event health status of survivors, and

WHEREAS, first responders (emergency medical personnel with approximately 40 hours of training) treat sudden cardiac death patients but are currently unable to defibrillate these patients, and

WHEREAS, objective quality assurance approaches can improve medical control and continuing education of emergency medical personnel trained in defibrillation;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

A. The King County executive is hereby authorized to make application for funds in the approximate amount of \$107,000 to the University of Washington for support of a project to develop first responder defibrillation and improved quality assurance programs for the early defibrillation in the King County emergency medical services division.
