MOTION NO. 8205

A MOTION relating to the update of the Vashon Sewer District Comprehensive Plan, requesting the commissioners to consider water availability in determining future sewerage needs.

WHEREAS, the Vashon Sewer District is in the process of updating its Sewer Comprehensive Plan, and

WHEREAS, the availability of water will have a major influence on the Islands' future development and sewerage needs, and

WHEREAS, the Seattle-King County department of health's current Vashon Water Study will not be completed prior to the conclusion of the Sewer Comprehensive Plan Update, and

WHEREAS, the 1983 Vashon/Maury Island Water Resources Study contains the most current available data on groundwater reserves within the Vashon Community Planning Area, and

WHEREAS, the 1990 Vashon Coordinated Water System Plan took into consideration the results of the 1983 water resources study, and

WHEREAS, the adopted zoning for the Town of Vashon is not based upon the findings of the 1983 Vashon/Maury Island Water Resources Study;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

A. As part of the update of their Sewer Comprehensive Plan, the Commissioners of the Vashon Sewer District are hereby requested to consider water availability as reflected in the Vashon/Maury Island Water Resources Study and the Vashon Coordinated Water System Plan.

1 B. The commissioners are further requested to consider the
2 possibility that the allowable densities within the Town of
3 Vashon may be reduced as a result of the Vashon Groundwater
4 Management Study currently underway.
