MOTION NO. 8224

A MOTION requesting the county executive to discontinue unauthorized remodeling work currently underway on the Yesler Building.

WHEREAS, the King County Charter reserves to the county council the authority to adopt budgets, and

WHEREAS, the King County Charter requires the executive to submit capital improvement plans to the council, and

WHEREAS, the King County Charter reserves to the county council the authority to approve capital improvement plans, and

WHEREAS, the council has appropriated funds for the purchase of the Yesler Building, and

WHEREAS, the council has not appropriated funds nor approved a capital improvement program for the renovation of the Yesler Building, and

WHEREAS, the executive has approved the unappropriated expenditure of funds to renovate the Yesler Building, and

WHEREAS, there is currently extensive renovation underway at the Yesler Building,

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT MOVED BY THE Council of King County: The executive is requested to immediately cease work on all unauthorized renovation work underway in the Yesler Building until such time as the council has approved a project scope and budget.
