2 A Motion concurring with the tasks assigned to
3 the King County Council in the Green-Duwamish
4 Watershed Nonpoint Action Plan and commending
5 the Green-Duwamish Watershed Management
6 Committee for its outstanding work in developing
7 the Plan.

8 WHEREAS, the Puget Sound Water Quality Authority 1987
9 Puget Sound Water Quality Management Plan directs the
10 counties bordering on Puget Sound to develop and implement
11 watershed action plans to control nonpoint sources of
12 pollution, and

13 WHEREAS, the King County council endorsed in Motion No.
14 6966 participation in the Puget Sound Water Quality
15 Authority's nonpoint pollution control planning program as
16 an effective means to protect and enhance water quality in
17 the Green-Duwamish Watershed and the Puget Sound basin, and

18 WHEREAS, the Green-Duwamish Watershed was selected by
19 the Washington Department of Ecology as an "Early Action
20 Watershed" where accelerated planning efforts were
21 necessary, and

22 WHEREAS, King County accepted State Centennial Clean
23 Water funds to lead the development and implementation of a
24 nonpoint action plan for the Green-Duwamish, and

25 WHEREAS, the Watershed Management Committee was formed
26 pursuant to WAC 400-12 and has, along with technical staff
27 from many different agencies, produced the Green-Duwamish
28 Watershed Nonpoint Action Plan, and

29 WHEREAS, the effectiveness of the Plan depends upon
30 cooperation among the numerous jurisdictions within the
31 watershed, and

32 WHEREAS, the King County Executive and his Departments
have reviewed and concurred with recommendations for County
actions, and

WHEREAS, the Green-Duwamish Nonpoint Action Plan
 1 recommends actions to be taken by the King County Council;

2 NOW THEREFORE BE IT MOVED by the council of King County:

3 A. The King County council concurs with the goals and
 4 objectives of the Green Duwamish Nonpoint Action Plan.

5 B. The King County Council agrees to carry out the
 6 recommended actions, given time and budget, as set forth in
 7 Attachment A.

8 C. The King County council commends the Watershed
 9 Management committee for its outstanding work in producing
 10 the Green Duwamish Nonpoint Action Plan.
