Brown, have recently won their fourth Sweepstakes Award at the  
Clark College Jazz Festival, and

WHEREAS, the Garfield Bulldogs, led by Director Clarence  
Acox, won First Place in their division as well as the  
Sweepstakes Award at the Viking Jazz Festival in Poulsbo, and

WHEREAS, the Franklin Quakers, led by Director Robert  
Pitzer, were honored as the top high school jazz group at the  
Grays Harbor Festival, and

WHEREAS, the students at each of these schools have worked  
hard at bake sales, car washes, hot dog sales, dances and  
auctions to raise the funding necessary to support the jazz  
bands, and

WHEREAS, Roosevelt High School is sponsoring the Third  
Annual Big Band Dance and Auction on March 23, and
