MOTION NO. 8249

A MOTION accepting the revised scope of work for the proposed S.E. 277th Street improvement feasibility study.

WHEREAS, the King County council has expressed an interest in the proposed improvements to S.E. 277th Street in unincorporated King County; and

WHEREAS, the King County Council has sought to respond to the concerns of the citizens of that area; and

WHEREAS, the King County council expressed its concerns in motion no. 8137 calling for the project's feasibility study to be expanded to include other potential alignments; and

WHEREAS, the motion also called for the development of a methodology for appointing a citizens' advisory committee to participate in this project; and

WHEREAS, the Executive has delivered a report to the council addressing the issues raised in motion no. 8137;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County: The King County council accepts the revised scope of work on the S.E. 277th Street corridor study presently underway and directs the Executive to begin the process of constituting a citizens' advisory committee.
