6 parks, beaches, and school grounds, detracts from the safe use,
7 unmarred appearance and enjoyment of lands which are held in
8 public trust, and

9 WHEREAS, thousands of volunteers are participating in
10 Spring Clean '91, April 13 through April 21, working countywide
11 to enhance the region's quality of life, and

12 WHEREAS, Spring Clean was established in 1982 by King
13 County's Department of Public Works in close cooperation with
14 the Department of Parks, Planning and Resources, inspiring
15 local city and statewide environmental cleanup events,
16 including Spring Rally, and

17 WHEREAS, Spring Clean '91 will mark the tenth year of a
18 successful, expanding program involving King County residents
19 in environmental cleanup, and

20 WHEREAS, the personal dedication of volunteers in such
21 cleanup efforts contribute in countless ways to the environment
22 and the quality of life in King County;
