MOTION NO. 8284

A MOTION requesting the executive to develop a work plan for implementing certain provisions of the Regional Governance Summit agreement.

WHEREAS, King County has participated in a Regional Governance Summit (Summit) together with the City of Seattle and Suburban Cities, and

WHEREAS, the Summit has made a series of recommendations to the public for reorganizing King County government, and

WHEREAS, after hearing public comments on the recommendations, the Summit will finalize a governance proposal for voter approval, and

WHEREAS, among the recommendations are certain actions which King County can initiate in advance of voter approval;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The executive is requested to develop a work plan for implementation of the following measures and submit it to the Council for review no later than June 10, 1991. The work plan should identify actions needed for implementation, a schedule for implementation and identification of responsible staff.

A. Establish separate revenue and expenditure accounting for unincorporated areas which will distinguish between regional and municipal services and between urban and rural services.

B. Strengthen King County's comprehensive plan policies for annexation/incorporation by:

1. Working with cities to adopt city growth area boundaries within the designated urban area of the county;

2. Establishing the county's intent to adopt applicable city design and site development standards for

1 urbanizing areas within any city growth areas and to offer to  
2 contract with the city to process land use permit applications;

3 3. Agreeing to evaluate a range of growth phasing  
4 techniques to ensure development concurrent with the provision  
5 of urban services by cities.

6 C. Working with cities to coordinate infrastructure  
7 development within city growth boundaries.

8 D. Reviewing rural density standards and create stronger  
9 separators between urban and rural to reduce impacts of each  
10 area on the other.
