MOTION NO. 8289

A MOTION authorizing the King County executive to enter into agreements with the Washington State Department of Ecology regarding the joint funding of comprehensive flood control studies and maintenance of flood control facilities.

WHEREAS, the Washington State Legislature created the Flood Control Assistance Account Program (FCAAP) for joint funding of flood control maintenance projects and related comprehensive flood control management plans pursuant to R.C.W. 86.26 and WAC 173-145, and

WHEREAS, the Washington State Department of Ecology is authorized by the above legislation to administer the sum of four million dollars each biennium for flood control maintenance projects and related comprehensive flood control management plans, and

WHEREAS, R.C.W. 86.26 and WAC 173-145 provide that grants will be available to counties, cities, and other public bodies for up to fifty percent of project planning, design, and construction costs for maintenance projects, up to eighty percent of emergency projects, and up to seventy-five percent of comprehensive flood control management plan costs, and

WHEREAS, the Washington State Department of Ecology has invited eligible counties to submit proposals for FCAAP fund grants for the 1991-1993 biennium, and

WHEREAS, the surface water management division of the King County department of public works has identified the need for detailed floodplain studies in the Snoqualmie, Cedar, and Skykomish River Basins, which experience severe and repeated flooding which threatens the life, health, and property of King County residents, and damages King County facilities including roads, bridges, levees, and revetments;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

A. The county executive is hereby authorized to develop and submit to the Washington State Department of Ecology proposals for the

Snoqualmie River, Cedar River, and Skykomish River Comprehensive Flood Control Management Plans described in attachment A.

B. The county executive is hereby authorized to submit FCAAP grant applications on behalf of the cities of Normandy Park, Issaquah, Seattle, and Bellevue in accordance with FCAAP funding guidelines provided by the Washington State Department of Ecology.

C. The county executive is hereby authorized to negotiate agreements with the Washington State Department of Ecology to accept grant funding for activities and facilities receiving final offers of financial assistance for the 1991-1993 biennium from the Washington State Department of Ecology.
