WHEREAS, on January 30, 1991, the King County Executive transmitted the Executive Proposed Surface Water Management Strategic Plan, and

WHEREAS, the Executive proposed Plan recommends continuation of the Surface Water Management program for an additional six years, and

WHEREAS, the Executive proposed Plan recommends continuation of the current program, acceleration of basin planning, initiation of capital projects, integration of water quality treatment into current and expanded activities, expansion of the service area, and bond financing of over \$81 million in capital projects with debt service paid by the surface water management service charge, and

WHEREAS, the service charge to finance the expanded program is proposed to be tripled over the next six years, and

WHEREAS, a notice sent to all those affected by the proposed rate increase is an appropriate manner to notify and inform the public of the proposal and provide them with the opportunity to participate;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County: The Council staff, in coordination with Executive staff, is directed to schedule a series of community meetings in which to inform the public of the proposal and to receive public comment.

The Council staff, in coordination with Executive staff, is also directed to prepare a notice to be sent to all surface water management ratepayers of the Executive proposed Surface Water Management Strategic Plan recommendations. The notice
