2 A MOTION requesting the Executive to  
3 negotiate an interlocal agreement for  
4 establishment of a subregional  
5 transportation planning steering  
6 committee in the south county area.

7 WHEREAS, since 1986 there has been an interjurisdictional  
8 steering committee including representatives of the cities of  
9 Auburn, Renton, Tukwila, Kent, and SeaTac; METRO; the Puget  
10 Sound Council of Governments; King County; and the private  
11 sector working toward development of a south county  
12 Transportation Benefit District (TBD); and

13 WHEREAS, that TBD steering committee has recommended to  
14 the King County council that a TBD be formed pursuant to  
15 Chapter 36.73 RCW; and

16 WHEREAS, the King County council has held public hearings  
17 on the proposal to form a TBD and has heard from the public  
18 that there is not sufficient public support at this time to  
19 form a TBD; and

20 WHEREAS, the King County council acknowledges that there  
21 remains an unmet need for additional transportation services in  
22 the south county and supports continuation of a  
23 multijurisdictional transportation planning process in the  
24 south county area;

25 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

26 The Executive is requested to negotiate and transmit to  
27 the Council for approval an interlocal agreement with the  
28 cities of Auburn, Kent, Tukwila, Renton and SeaTac to create a  
29 steering committee for the purposes of coordinating  
30 transportation plans in the south county area sponsoring a  
31 financing study to analyze the unmet transportation needs in  
32 the south county area and alternatives for financing a portion

1 of those needs. The agreement should provide for the steering  
2 committee to recommend to the King County Council and the other  
3 jurisdictions how additional transportation needs in that area  
4 should be financed.
