A MOTION authorizing the relinquishment of a covenant for a storm drainage infiltration pond recorded under recording No. 8501160679, in Council District 1.

WHEREAS, King County and Wood Associates, a Washington partnership, entered into a covenant (Recording No. 8501160679) for the purposes of construction, operation and maintenance of a storm drain infiltration pond, and

WHEREAS, paragraph 2 of the covenant provides for a release if an approved alternate storm water design is developed, and

WHEREAS, the building and land development division, site review section has reviewed this matter and states that alternate downstream drainage improvements have been completed, and

WHEREAS, the building and land development division recommends that King County relinquish the covenant as the infiltration pond described in the recorded covenant is no longer necessary, and

WHEREAS, the council of King County deems it in the best interests of the citizens of King County to relinquish the drainage covenant;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the council of King County:

The King County executive is authorized to execute the instruments necessary to relinquish King County's right, title, and interest in the drainage covenant (Recording No. 8501160679).
