A MOTION authorizing the Executive Finance Committee to make interim loans of up to \$4,900,000 to the Building and Land Development Fund from a consortium of Public Works capital funds.

WHEREAS, the Building and Land Development Fund is experiencing immediate cash flow shortfalls that will require interim financing, and

WHEREAS, a long term program to restore the Building and Land Development fund to an acceptable financial status is dependent on immediate efforts to improve productivity and reduce backlogs of work within the fund, and

WHEREAS, there are significant issues to be resolved during the remainder of 1991 related to identifying total borrowing requirements and financial sharing of loan and deficit costs between fee and non-fee based elements associated with the BALD fund, and

WHEREAS, the Executive Finance Committee has authorized an additional loan commitment of up to \$1,000,000 from the County Road Construction Fund on an interim basis, to provide time for Council consideration of additional loan requirements, and

WHEREAS, projections of loan requirements through the remainder of 1991 indicate that total loan needs of up to \$4,900,000 including the interim loan of \$1,000,000 may be required if significant steps are to be taken to reduce work backlogs, improve financial and information systems, and enhance productivity, and

WHEREAS, there is a consortium of public works capital funds that can provide the cash resources for a BALD loan as an investment of existing funds without impacting existing project commitments this year;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The executive finance committe is hereby authorized to make
a loan of up to \$4,900,000 to the Building and Land Development
