

MOTION **8.412**

A MOTION authorizing the County executive to make a grant application for funds in the approximate amount of \$2,000,000 to develop and evaluate community-based interventions targeting women at risk for HIV infection in the Seattle-King County area.

WHEREAS, the Centers for Disease Control (CDC) is authorized to make grants of funds to develop model intervention programs for women at risk for HIV infection, and

WHEREAS, the AIDS epidemic is increasingly affecting women, and through them, their unborn infants, and

WHEREAS, subgroups of these women can be identified, and

WHEREAS, the grant funds will allow the development and evaluation of pragmatic and cost effective intervention models targeting these subgroups, and

WHEREAS, the council recognizes that the funds secured through an approval of the application by the Centers for Disease Control will support the entire cost of the evaluation;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

A. The King County executive is hereby authorized to make application for funds in the approximate amount of \$2,000,000 to the Centers for Disease Control to develop a model to provide interventions targeting women at risk for HIV infection;

B. The King County executive is hereby authorized to file and execute such contracts as are required by the grantor.
