A MOTION approving King County's participation in a grant application for drug elimination funds by King County housing authority from the U. S. Department of Housing and Urban Development.

WHEREAS, The King County housing authority and King County are both concerned with the illegal use of drugs and drug-related crime, and

WHEREAS, the King County housing authority has worked closely with the King County department of public safety, including contracting for enhanced patrols at the Springwood and Cascade Apartment public housing communities east of Kent, and

WHEREAS, the King County housing authority has made an application to the U. S. Department of Housing and Urban Development for drug elimination funding in the amount of \$591,904, and

WHEREAS, the King County housing authority has included in said application three opportunities for contracting with the King County department of public safety totalling \$140,000;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The King County department of public safety is authorized to participate in the application by the King County housing authority for 1991-1992 drug elimination grant funds from the U. S. Department of Housing and Urban Development.
