A MOTION proclaiming the week of January 13 through January 18, 1992 Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Week in King County.

WHEREAS, "You Make the Difference - Realizing Unity," is the theme for the Fifth Annual Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Celebration, focusing on the equality of employees and departments of King County, and

WHEREAS, this year's celebration highlights the culturally diverse population of King County's work force and the importance of respecting and appreciating these differences through unification, and

WHEREAS, Dr. King, born on January 15, 1929, worked to unite and protect the rights of all individuals, prompting the passage of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 and the Voting Rights Act of 1965, and

WHEREAS, on February 24, 1986, the King County Council set forth the historical basis for redesignating King County in honor of Dr. King;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County: the week of January 13 through January 18, 1992 is proclaimed Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Week in King County.

BE IT FURTHER MOVED: the Council recognizes the cultural diversity of the county's work force and upholds Dr. King's conviction in promoting the principles of equality and self-worth for all individuals.
