## MOTION NO. 8574

A MOTION authorizing the County Executive to make a grant application for funds in the approximate amount of \$2,900,160 to support a study of case management services, Grant File No. 203.

WHEREAS, injecting drug users have been shown to underutilize and utilize inappropriately existing social support and service programs, and

WHEREAS, injection drug use is a significant factor in the transmission of the Human Immunodeficiency Virus (HIV) and the incidence of the Acquired Immune Deficiency Syndrome (AIDS), and

WHEREAS, a significant number of inmates released from the 14 King County jail admit to the use of illicit drugs by 15 injection, and 16

WHEREAS, case management services have been shown to improve treatment outcomes and reduce the inappropriate use of social and health services in certain groups, and

WHEREAS, the impact of office-based and community-based case management services on an injecting drug using population has not been documented in research, and

WHEREAS, the case management services study will enable the collection of data regarding the results of different forms of case management services to individuals released from the King County jail and enable evaluation of the results of the different services, and

WHEREAS, the Department of Health and Human Services, through the National Institute on Drug Abuse, is empowered to make grants in support of programs which could improve the effectiveness of drug abuse treatment services and help to reduce the spread of HIV/AIDS in this country;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County: A. The King County executive is hereby authorized to make application for funds in the approximate amount of \$2,900,160

to the Department of Health and Human Services, National Institute on Drug Abuse, for a study of case management services available to injecting drug users on behlaf of King County;

B. The King County executive is hereby authorized to file and execute such application and to enter into and execute such contracts as are required by the grantor;

C. The Department of Health and Human Services, National Institute on Drug Abuse is hereby assured to full compliance with Title VI of the Civil, Rights Act.
