2 A MOTION authorizing the execution of an
3 interlocal cooperation agreement with the
4 Cities of Bellevue, Auburn, and Federal
5 Way for the purpose of carrying out
6 activities authorized and funded by the
7 federal HOME Investment Partnerships
8 program for the year 1993.

9 WHEREAS, the federal HOME Investment Partnerships program
10 makes funds available to King County for the purpose of
11 acquiring, rehabilitating, and constructing housing that is
12 affordable to low and moderate-income people, and

13 WHEREAS, King County receives these funds as the
14 representative member of an urban county consortium formed by
15 agreement for housing and community development purposes for
16 the three-year period 1991-1993, and

17 WHEREAS, the cities of Bellevue, Auburn, and Federal Way
18 are neither part of the aforementioned urban county consortium,
19 nor are they eligible to receive an allocation of HOME
20 Investment Partnerships program funds directly from the federal
21 government, and

22 WHEREAS, federal regulations allow these cities to join
23 the existing King County consortium for HOME Investment
24 Partnerships program purposes for the remainder of the three-
25 year period of the urban county consortium agreement, and

26 WHEREAS, the total HOME Investment Partnerships program
27 funds available to the King County consortium would increase
28 approximately 24 percent if these cities were to join the
29 consortium for 1993, and

30 WHEREAS, the shortage of affordable housing for low and
31 moderate-income people is a regional problem on which it is
32 desirable to have the cooperation of all suburban cities in the
33 region;

34 NOW, THEREFORE BE IT MOVED by the Council King County:

35 A. The county executive is hereby authorized to negotiate
36 and sign an interlocal cooperation agreement in substantially

1 the form as attached with the cities of Bellevue, Auburn, and
2 Federal Way for the purpose of carrying out activities
3 authorized and funded by the federal HOME Investment
4 Partnerships program for the year 1993.


5 B. The executive is requested to account for
6 administrative costs attributable to local administration of
7 HOME programs to establish the basis for a county request for
8 federal funds when HOME is considered for renewal in the fall,
9 1992.
