A MOTION authorizing the execution of an interlocal cooperation agreement with the Cities of Bellevue, Auburn, and Federal Way for the purpose of carrying out activities authorized and funded by the federal HOME Investment Partnerships program for the year 1993.

WHEREAS, the federal HOME Investment Partnerships program makes funds available to King County for the purpose of acquiring, rehabilitating, and constructing housing that is affordable to low and moderate-income people, and

WHEREAS, King County receives these funds as the representative member of an urban county consortium formed by agreement for housing and community development purposes for the three-year period 1991-1993, and

WHEREAS, the cities of Bellevue, Auburn, and Federal Way are neither part of the aforementioned urban county consortium, nor are they eligible to receive an allocation of HOME Investment Partnerships program funds directly from the federal government, and

WHEREAS, federal regulations allow these cities to join the existing King County consortium for HOME Investment Partnerships program purposes for the remainder of the three-year period of the urban county consortium agreement, and

WHEREAS, the total HOME Investment Partnerships program funds available to the King County consortium would increase approximately 24 percent if these cities were to join the consortium for 1993, and

WHEREAS, the shortage of affordable housing for low and moderate-income people is a regional problem on which it is desirable to have the cooperation of all suburban cities in the region;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT MOVED by the Council King County:

A. The county executive is hereby authorized to negotiate and sign an interlocal cooperation agreement in substantially
