I will visit an aquarium, nature center or museum to 25 learn more about Puget Sound's fish, animals and birds. 26 2. I will plant trees, shrubs and flowers to slow the 27 flow of water runoff into Puget Sound. 28 3. I will conserve water at home and at work, because 29 clean, fresh water is the life blood of Puget Sound. 30 31 4. I will store and use as little chemical weed and bug 32 killer as possible.
