

MOTION NO. 8609

2 A MOTION authorizing the King County Executive to accept  
3 a grant from the Clean Washington Center to implement a  
4 pilot program for testing of recycled glass cullet in road  
5 applications.

6 WHEREAS, King County has adopted a goal of recycling and reducing the  
7 waste stream by sixty-five percent by the year 2000, and

8 WHEREAS, a glut of recycled glass currently exists in King County, and

9 WHEREAS, research is needed regarding the use of recycled glass cullet  
10 in road construction applications in order to assess the feasibility of  
11 widespread use of recycled glass in King County construction projects, and

12 WHEREAS, the department of public works has proposed a demonstration  
13 road paving project using recycled glass as a component of asphalt concrete,  
14 and

15 WHEREAS, recyclers, refuse haulers, and glass processors in King County  
16 may offer to provide in-kind contributions of recycled glass cullet and  
17 transportation services for the pilot project, and

18 WHEREAS, the Clean Washington Center has established a grant program for  
19 projects which demonstrate the feasibility of using recycled materials from  
20 Washington state in public works projects, and

21 WHEREAS, the department of public works has proposed including recycled  
22 glass in existing road construction and road maintenance programs and budgets;

23 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

24 A. The county executive is authorized to accept such grant funds from  
25 the Clean Washington Center as are necessary for the implementation of a  
26 project using recycled glass as a component of asphalt concrete in an  
27 experimental road construction project.

28 B. The county executive is authorized to enter into and execute such  
29 contracts as are required by the grantor for the purpose of the experimental  
30 road construction project.

31 C. The county executive is authorized to accept in-kind contributions  
32 of recycled glass cullet and transportation services from private operators,  
33

not to exceed one hundred thousand dollars in value, for use in the pilot road construction project.
