2 A MOTION requesting the Executive to
3 prepare and forward an ordinance granting
4 vacation request V-2025.

5 WHEREAS, the King County department of public works has
6 reviewed vacation request V-2025 and has denied it; and

7 WHEREAS, petitioners have asked that this denial be
8 reviewed and overturned by the King County council; and

9 WHEREAS, this matter was initially considered by the
10 council's transportation and public works committee at its
11 meeting of April 11, 1990; and

12 WHEREAS, at that meeting the members of the committee
13 considered the facts in this matter; and

14 WHEREAS, the subject right-of-way if built as an access
15 road would intrude upon a private nature trail; and

16 WHEREAS, it came to light at that meeting that the subject
17 right-of-way might be needed for public purposes due to the
18 proposed construction of a school nearby; and

19 WHEREAS, the committee deferred making a decision until
20 the school district had acquired the necessary construction
21 permits and it became evident whether or not the subject right-
22 of-way would be needed for access to the school; and

23 WHEREAS, the school district has acquired the necessary
24 construction permits, is in the process of construction, and
25 does not need the subject right-of-way for access purposes;

26 NOW, THEREFORE BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

27 A. The King County council finds that the requested road
28 vacation meets the conditions and requirements set by its
29 transportation and public works committee at its meeting of
30 April 11, 1990.

31 B. The Executive is requested to prepare, and forward to
32 the council for its consideration, an ordinance granting
33 proposed road vacation V-2025. Said ordinance shall include

1 provision for an easement with a width of at least ten feet for
2 pedestrian access purposes.
