MOTION NO. **8706**

A MOTION approving completion of the Harborview Medical Center Long Range Capital Improvement Project Design Phase, adding project elements and providing authority to proceed to the development of construction documents.

WHEREAS, design documents for the Harborview Medical Center Long Range Capital Improvement Project are complete, and

WHEREAS, the design documents have been reviewed by the Harborview Medical Center Board of Trustees, Administrative Staff and Department User Groups and approved conditioned by the terms as outlined in Attachment A, and

WHEREAS, the Maximum Allowable Construction Costs identified as \$86,650,398 are within the project scope and budget and outlined in Attachment B, and

WHEREAS, the design documents have been reviewed and approved by the King County LRCIP Oversight Committee as conditioned by Attachments A and B;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

1. The executive is hereby authorized to proceed to the construction document phase provided that the design issues, as referenced in Attachment A, are resolved within the parameters of the budget as outlined in Attachment B.

2. Additional design and structural upgrade of the ambulatory care facility for purposes of future potential addition of two floors is hereby approved to be funded from Harborview HCFA funds. Construction of the added floors will require scope change approval by the council.

3. Design of the pneumatic tube system is hereby approved, provided that, Harborview HCFA funds are made available for the system, and further provided that, the system will not be built in renovated space unless it is found by the architect, county
