2 A MOTION authorizing application for
3 funding assistance for an Aquatic Lands
4 Enhancement Account project to the
5 Department of Natural Resources.

6 WHEREAS, under the provisions of Chapter 79.24.580, RCW,
7 state funding assistance has been authorized and made available
8 to aid in financing the cost of land and the construction of
9 facilities for public access to, and aquatic land enhancement
10 of, state-owned aquatic lands;

11 WHEREAS, the Department of Natural Resources has invited
12 local governments to apply for grants not to exceed \$200,000
13 for the purpose of developing wetland stewardship projects;

14 WHEREAS, the King County Council created the King County
15 Wetlands Preservation Program on October 7, 1991, with
16 signature of Ordinance 10143.

17 WHEREAS, the King County Wetland Preservation Program
18 establishes procedures and guidelines for a non-regulatory
19 wetlands preservation program;

20 WHEREAS, the preservation program is focused on improving
21 the effectiveness of regulatory efforts in order to meet the
22 goal of no net loss of wetland functions and values;

23 WHEREAS, the Seattle-King County Land Trust and the Green
24 River Community College are interested in participating in a
25 cooperative effort with King County in wetland preservation
26 effort under this grant; and

27 WHEREAS, the grant application deadline is July 8, 1992;

28 NOW, THEREFORE BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

29 1. That the executive be authorized to make formal
30 application to the Department of Natural Resources for a grant
31 for the acquisition of a portion of the Carnation Marsh, not to
32 exceed \$200,000 under the Aquatic Lands Enhancement Account;
