A MOTION authorizing an interlocal agreement between King County, Snohomish County, and the City of Redmond to implement the Bear Creek Basin Plan.

WHEREAS, King County has adopted the Bear Creek Basin Plan as a functional plan that implements the surface water management and environmental policies of the King County Comprehensive Plan, and

WHEREAS, the Bear Creek Basin Plan establishes a basin management program to protect significant fisheries resources, and to reduce flooding, erosion, sediment deposition, water pollution, and aquatic habitat damage, and

WHEREAS, King County, Snohomish County, and the City of Redmond share jurisdiction in the area of the basin, and

WHEREAS, the parties recognize the benefits of cooperative planning, managing, and implementation of the Bear Creek Basin Plan, and

WHEREAS, pursuant to R.C.W. 39.34, the Interlocal Cooperative Act, the parties are each authorized to enter into an agreement for cooperative action, and


WHEREAS, prompt and effective implementation of the Bear Creek Basin Plan is crucial to achieve its objectives;
