MOTION NO. 8727

A MOTION authorizing the King County Executive to enter into an agreement with the Washington State Department of Ecology regarding the joint funding of plans and projects which improve water quality in King County pursuant to Chapter 70.146 RCW.

WHEREAS, the Washington State legislature has created the Centennial Clean Water Fund for the joint funding of water quality improvement plans and projects with other public agencies in the state pursuant to Chapter 70.146 RCW, and

WHEREAS, the Washington State legislature has adopted the 1987 and 1989 Puget Sound Water Quality Management Plans requiring local governments to conduct certain planning and implementation activities related to preserving or improving water quality in Puget Sound and in waters tributary to Puget Sound, and

WHEREAS, the Washington State Department of Ecology is currently drafting regulations to control the disposal of liquids (decant) and sediment derived from drainage facility maintenance to limit potential water quality impacts, and

WHEREAS, the King County department of public works has applied for and been offered a Centennial Clean Water Fund grant by the Washington State Department of Ecology to develop an Interjurisdictional Decant/Sediment Disposal Plan, and

1 WHEREAS, state requirements include a twenty-five percent local match  
2 for grant moneys received;

3 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

4 The county executive is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement  
5 in substantially the form attached with the Washington State Department of  
6 Ecology to accept grant funding for the Interjurisdictional Decant/Sediment  
7 Disposal Plan.
