- C. Every office or directorship held by the employee, or his or her immediate family in any person or other governmental entity doing business in King County; and
- D. A list by legal description or popular address of all real property owned in King County by the employee, or his or her immediate family, including options to buy if the property is valued in excess of one thousand five hundred dollars; and
- E. All real property located in King County, divested by the employee or his or her immediate family during the reporting year, the value of which exceeds one thousand five hundred dollars; and
- F.
