A MOTION adopting the King County Regional Trails Plan.

WHEREAS, the King County Comprehensive Plan states that a variety of lands, including trails, should be preserved for park and open space purposes, and

WHEREAS, the King County council recognizes the benefits of a regional trail network in the King County Open Space Plan adopted by Ordinance No. 8657, and

WHEREAS, the King County Open Space Plan sets forth guidance and policies for the protection of open space and trails, and

WHEREAS, the King County Open Space Plan specifies that trail corridors shown in the plan are conceptual and precise details are to be determined at a later phase, and

WHEREAS, trails are becoming increasingly popular as a recreational activity and as a means of commuting by residents of King County;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The attached Regional Trails Plan is approved to provide guidance for the continued development of a safe and pleasurable regional trail system.
