A MOTION directing that space on the twelfth floor of the Courthouse be prepared to accommodate the 1994 thirteen member metropolitan county council and staff.

WHEREAS, the voters have approved the addition of four members to the King County council effective January 1, 1994, and

WHEREAS, current space occupied by the county council and its staff on the fourth floor of the courthouse is the farthest below county space standards of any county agency and is inadequate to meet present needs, and

WHEREAS, there is no added space currently available on the fourth floor of the courthouse to meet the additional needs of the 1994 council, and

WHEREAS, the council wishes to remain in the courthouse, and

WHEREAS, a move of the council to the twelfth floor of the courthouse is the least cost option for staying in the courthouse because it avoids moving other agencies, and

WHEREAS, the cost to provide space for the council on the twelfth floor of the courthouse is a lower cost option because the space is currently unoccupied so demolition costs are minimal and new rent costs are not incurred, and

WHEREAS, remodeling work must begin immediately in order to have space prepared by January 1, 1994 and the twelfth floor option will take the least time to complete, and

WHEREAS, the facilities division is best capable of meeting the necessary schedule in preparing the space,

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The King County Council hereby directs that space be prepared by the facilities management division for thirteen council members, council support staff, the council central

1 staff, and the council clerk on the twelfth floor of the  
2 courthouse. A detailed floor plan and budget, previously  
3 requested by the council from the office of capital planning,  
4 shall be presented to the council as soon as possible for  
5 approval so that work may commence immediately. Accommodations  
6 for the committee meeting room needed to support the new  
7 regional committees shall also be included in space  
8 preparations in the courthouse. Renovation, remodeling and  
9 finishing work necessary to provide the space shall be the  
10 responsibility of the facilities management division.
