MOTION NO. 8843

A MOTION relating to the terms of office of members of the Harborview Medical Center board of trustees, providing that members may be appointed to serve three terms notwithstanding the 12-year limitation established in Motion 5357.

WHEREAS, Motion 5357 established a 12-year limit for the length of terms of members of certain specified boards, commissions, and committees, including the Harborview Board of Trustees, and

WHEREAS, although Ordinance 6818, adopted in 1986, established terms of four years and a three-term limit for members of the Harborview board, prior terms had been for periods of six years, and

WHEREAS, members originally appointed prior to the adoption of Ordinance 6818 who have served two terms would be eligible under the terms of that ordinance to serve a third term but for the 12-year limit established by Motion 5357, and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of the public to provide continuity and to utilize fully the expertise of Harborview board members gained during two terms by allowing their appointment for a third term for a total service of 14 years on the board;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

Notwithstanding the provisions of Motion 5357, members of the Harborview Board of Trustees may serve three terms as authorized by Ordinance 6818 even if the total years of such
