

MOTION NO. 8843

2 A MOTION relating to the terms of office  
3 of members of the Harborview Medical  
4 Center board of trustees, providing that  
5 members may be appointed to serve three  
6 terms notwithstanding the 12-year  
7 limitation established in Motion 5357.

8 WHEREAS, Motion 5357 established a 12-year limit for the  
9 length of terms of members of certain specified boards,  
10 commissions, and committees, including the Harborview Board of  
11 Trustees, and

12 WHEREAS, although Ordinance 6818, adopted in 1986,  
13 established terms of four years and a three-term limit for  
14 members of the Harborview board, prior terms had been for  
15 periods of six years, and

16 WHEREAS, members originally appointed prior to the  
17 adoption of Ordinance 6818 who have served two terms would be  
18 eligible under the terms of that ordinance to serve a third  
19 term but for the 12-year limit established by Motion 5357, and

20 WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of the public to  
21 provide continuity and to utilize fully the expertise of  
22 Harborview board members gained during two terms by allowing  
23 their appointment for a third term for a total service of 14  
24 years on the board;

25 NOW, THEREFORE BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

26 A. Notwithstanding the provisions of Motion 5357, members  
27 of the Harborview Board of Trustees may serve three terms as  
28 authorized by Ordinance 6818 even if the total years of such


1 service would exceed twelve years.
