A MOTION authorizing the King County executive to submit an application for funding for the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development 1993 Emergency Shelter Grants Program.

WHEREAS, housing the homeless is a pressing community and human services need, and

WHEREAS, emergency shelter and services are critical to homeless families working toward self-sufficiency, and

WHEREAS, eligible activities for Emergency Shelter Grants (ESG) Program funds include homeless prevention assistance, supportive services, rehabilitation, and operating costs associated with emergency shelter, and

WHEREAS, King County will receive an entitlement of \$72,000 of ESG funding from the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development, and


WHEREAS, the King County council has appropriated funds for ESG in Budget Ordinance 10641;
