A MOTION authorizing the County Executive to enter into grant agreements in the amount of \$8,473,710 for the period December 4, 1992 through April 3, 1996 in order to provide HIV-related care and support services to residents of the Seattle Metropolitan Area.

WHEREAS, the Health Resources and Services Administration (HRSA), through the Ryan White Comprehensive AIDS Resources Emergency Act of 1990, is authorized to make grants of funds to Eligible Metropolitan Areas (EMA) to provide HIV-related care and support services, and

WHEREAS, the Seattle Metropolitan Area is eligible to receive Title 1 funding since cumulative reported AIDS cases exceed 2000, and

WHEREAS, the AIDS epidemic continues to impact Seattle Metropolitan Area residents, resulting in the inability of people with HIV to obtain medical care and services, and

WHEREAS, the Seattle-King County department of public health has made two applications for this funding: the formula portion entitled "HIV/AIDS Continuum of Care Services for King and Snohomish Counties" in the amount of \$1,091,801 per year; and the supplemental (or competitive) portion entitled "HIV/AIDS Continuum of Care Services for King and Snohomish Counties (Seattle EMA)" in the amount of \$1,637,466 per year, and

WHEREAS, the department has received notice of an award for the competitive grant of \$1,732,769, making a total award of \$2,824,570 per year, or \$8,473,710 for the three year period, and

WHEREAS, the department has established an HIV Health Services Planning Council that has fulfilled requirements for supplemental funding, and

WHEREAS, the funding will provide much needed relief to the local community in terms of planning for and managing HIVrelated care and support services;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

A. The King County executive is hereby authorized to make two applications for funds in the amount of \$8,187,741 over a three year period to the Health Resources and Services Administration for HIV-related funding;

B. The King County executive is hereby authorized to file and execute such application and to enter into and execute such contracts as are required by the grantor for the actual award of \$8,473,710;

C. The King County executive is also authorized to enter into and execute such subcontracts as are necessary for the implementation of the project.
