WHEREAS, the department of youth services, in conjunction with the superior court, office of the prosecuting attorney, county law enforcement, and county juvenile public defenders, requires funds for technical assistance to analyze racial disproportionality data obtained from the juvenile justice system, and

WHEREAS, the council of King County finds that the provision of funds for racial disproportionality data analysis is in the public interest;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

- A. The King County executive is hereby authorized to make application for funds in the approximate amount of \$3,500 to the Governor's Juvenile Justice Advisory Committee, for the provision of funds to analyze racial disproportionality data;
- B. The King County executive is hereby authorized to file and execute such application and to enter into and execute such contracts as are required by the grantor:
- C. The King County executive is also authorized to enter into and execute such subcontracts as are necessary for the implementation of the project;
