MOTION NO. **9048**

A MOTION authorizing the King County Executive to enter into an agreement with the Washington State Department of Ecology regarding the joint funding of drainage mapping, discharge characterization, and removal of non-stormwater discharges pursuant to Chapter 70.146 RCW.

WHEREAS, the Washington State legislature has created the Centennial Clean Water Fund for the joint funding of water quality improvement plans and projects with other public agencies in the state pursuant to Chapter 70.146 RCW, and

WHEREAS, the federal Clean Water Act (40 CFR Parts 122, 123, and 124) requires King County to apply for a National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System municipal stormwater permit to reduce the discharge of pollutants in stormwater to the maximum extent practicable, and

WHEREAS, the King County department of public works has applied for and been offered a Centennial Clean Water Fund grant by the Washington State Department of Ecology to improve water quality in King County as authorized by King County Council Motion No. 8517, and

WHEREAS, the grant will enable the surface water management division to develop maps of the constructed drainage system, including all outfalls, in the Black River, Duwamish River, and Mill Creek drainage basins, and

WHEREAS, the outfalls identified during mapping will be inspected and characterized during periods of dry weather in order to identify non-stormwater discharges, and

WHEREAS, all identified non-stormwater discharges to the drainage system will be reported to surface water management division drainage investigation and regulation staff for follow-up and possible enforcement to remove the discharges, and


WHEREAS, state requirements include a fifty percent local match for grant monies received and the King County surface water management division has appropriated its share in the 1993 budget;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The county executive is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement in substantially the form attached with the Washington State Department of Ecology to accept grant funding for the mapping of drainage systems in the Black River, Duwamish River, and Mill Creek drainage basins, for the characterization of the discharges to those drainage systems, and the removal of non-stormwater discharges from those systems.
