code, deferred action on certain proposed sections of the code
relating to livestock, and

WHEREAS, the motion deferring such action called for the
establishment of a fair, balanced and impartial panel to seek a
compromise on the proposed regulations and report its
recommendations to the council by July 31, 1993, and

WHEREAS, the motion deferring action called for the chair
of the council to appoint such a panel, and


WHEREAS, the council would like to publicly acknowledge

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:
The Livestock Management Panel shall consist of a panel of
citizens and stakeholders as identified in Attachment A, dated
8/16/93, which shall be supported by council, executive, and
resource agency staff.

The Panel is urged to seek workable compromises which recognize
the importance of the county's aquatic and agricultural
resources, within the timeframe called for by the council (July
31, 1993).
