9126 MOTION NO. 1 A MOTION relating to the Boulevard 2 Park/White Center, Shoreline and Vashon/ 3 Maury Island Governance Strategies 4 Committees' recommendations. 5 WHEREAS, Ordinance 10037 established a process for 6 communities to study and recommend governance strategies to the 7 council; 8 9 WHEREAS, in 1992 the council appointed Governance Strategies Committees in the communities of Boulevard 10 11 Park/White Center, Shoreline and Vashon/Maury Island to prepare recommendations to the council by June 1993; 12 WHEREAS, the Committees after considerable study and 13 thoughtful deliberation forwarded recommendations to the 14 council in a timely manner; and 15 WHEREAS, Ordinance 10037 requires the council to address 16 17 the recommendations within 90 days from June 30; NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County: 18 Acceptance of reports. The reports from the 19 Section 1. Boulevard Park/White Center, Shoreline and Vashon/Maury Island 20 Governance Strategies Committees are accepted. The members of 21 22 the Committees are commended for their dedication to their communities which contributed to the production of the numerous 23 recommendations contained in the reports. 24 Community information. The summary of the 25 Section 2. final reports from the Governance Strategies Committees will be 26 provided to all public libraries in the County. Full reports 27 from the local Committee will be distributed to local library 28 branch(es) and local community groups. 29 Section 3. Extension of committee appointments. The 30 Governance Strategies Committee appointments are extended 31 through December 31, 1994 for the purposes of providing a 32 source of information in the community about governance and for 33 monitoring further work as directed by the council on 34 govstrt.jc/09-10-93/10:05am/ Page 1

recommendations. Meetings will be held on an as-needed basis only. The council budget for 1994 shall include staff and other resources to permit effective extension of these Committees.

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Community Councils. In response to the Section 4. 5 recommendation that "enhanced community councils" for 6 unincorporated areas of King County be authorized, the council 7 staff is directed to prepare for council consideration county 8 legislation addressing the council's support of community 9 The legislation should include how community councils. 10 councils are established or recognized, the types of issues on 11 which the community councils would be asked to advise the King 12 County council, how the council would facilitate communication 13 to and from these community groups, including evaluation of the 14 options of local service centers offering access to a range of 15 public services. In addition, the council recognizes that the 16 Governance Strategies Committee reports will be useful to the 17 State legislature in any consideration of authorizing of 18 "enhanced community councils" for King County. 19

Section 5. Annexation. In response to the 20 recommendations that the council assist these communities to 21 remain as now constituted, the council intends to have the 22 County invoke jurisdiction of the Washington State Boundary 23 Review Board for King County (WSBRB) on annexations which 24 affect these communities and to report on the Governance 25 Strategies Committees' results to the Board. 26 The council staff is directed to prepare for council 27 consideration, as part of its 1994 State legislative package, 28 legislation a) to allow for the WSBRB having a more concurrent. 29 review of annexations and incorporations affecting the same 30 communities, provided that annexations are not unduly impeded 31 32 and b) to constrain annexations without a vote where a significant number of citizens are affected. 33

34 Section 6. <u>Evaluation of new governance options</u>. Should 35 they be presented to the county council, the council staff is
