MOTION NO. 9171

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A MOTION requesting the Boundary Review Board to review the City of Woodinville's proposed annexations of the "Vermeulen", "South Central", "Sewell", "Manny" and "Kyes" pursuant to RCW 36.93.100.

WHEREAS, the Washington State Boundary Review Board For King County was created to provide a neutral forum for the public review of proposed annexations and incorporations, and

WHEREAS the purpose and objectives of the Washington State Boundary Review Board For King County as set out in RCW 36.93.010 and 36.93.180 include among others, to achieve consistent comprehensive land use plans for populated areas, to avoid competition to extend municipal boundaries, to prevent haphazard boundary extensions, to create and preserve logical service areas and to protect agricultural and rural lands, and

WHEREAS, the City of Woodinville on November 5, 1993 filed a notice of intention to annex the five areas known as "Vermeulen", "South Central", "Sewell", "Manny" and "Kyes", and

WHEREAS, RCW 36.93.100 provides for the Washington State Boundary Review Board For King County to review proposed annexations, and King County Ordinance No. 8389 provides for a means of requesting such review, and

WHEREAS, the Growth Management Act mandates coordinated planning between the counties required to plan under the Act and the cities in those counties, and

WHEREAS, the Growth Management Act further required the adoption of countywide planning policies which are to direct the detailed planning work for county and city comprehensive plans, and

WHEREAS, the countywide planning policies were developed in collaboration with the cities through the Growth Management

1 Planning Council, and were adopted by the county council on  
2 July 6, 1992, (Ordinance No. 10450), and

3 WHEREAS, the adopted countywide planning policies were  
4 ratified by 30% of the cities in King County representing 70%  
5 of the incorporated population of King County, and

6 WHEREAS, the adopted county planning policies established  
7 as policy an urban growth area which excludes all of the areas  
8 proposed to be annexed by the City of Woodinville, and

9 WHEREAS, the county has adopted interim urban growth areas  
10 as required by the Growth Management Act, and all of the  
11 annexations proposed by the City of Woodinville are outside of  
12 the interim urban growth area, and the urban growth area  
13 adopted in the county planning policies, and

14 WHEREAS, the Growth Management Act prohibits cities from  
15 annexing areas outside the urban growth area established  
16 pursuant to the Act, and

17 WHEREAS, the public is best served by open public hearing  
18 and review of these issues;


1 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

4 following actions:

8 Nos. 1840, 1841, 1842, 1843 and 1844.
