PROPOSED NO. 93-752

MOTION NO. **9176**

A MOTION authorizing the executive to apply for Coordinated Prevention Grant funds from the Referenda 26 & 39 accounts in the approximate amount of \$760,000 to reimburse, in part, implementation costs of the King County Comprehensive Solid Waste Management Plan.

WHEREAS, King County is required by RCW 70.95, K.C.C. 10.22, and by the Solid Waste Interlocal Agreement to develop and implement a Comprehensive Solid Waste Management Plan, and

WHEREAS, WAC 173-312 provides for the award of Coordinated Prevention Grants by the Washington State Department of Ecology pursuant to RCW 70.105D.070(3) (the Model Toxics Control Act) to assist local governments with hazardous and solid waste management planning and program implementation, and

WHEREAS, funds from the Referenda 26 & 39 accounts have been committed to local governments as a one-time additional funding source within the Coordinated Prevention Grant program to be used specifically for waste reduction and recycling capital projects, and

WHEREAS, the King County council recognizes an obligation to provide approximately \$507,000 in matching funds, and

WHEREAS, this match shall be met within 1994 through 1997 appropriated expenditure authority;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:


A. The King County executive is hereby authorized to apply to the Department of Ecology for approximately \$760,000 to reimburse, in part, the costs of implementing the Comprehensive Solid Waste Management Plan.

B. The King County executive is hereby authorized to execute such contracts as are required by the grantor.

C. The Department of Ecology is hereby assured of full compliance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act.
