2 A MOTION authorizing an interlocal agreement between
3 King County, the Green River Flood Control Zone
4 District, and the City of Tukwila to establish
5 construction, maintenance, and local cost-sharing
6 responsibilities for the Segale Levee Project on the
7 Green River.

8 WHEREAS, Tukwila and King County share jurisdiction over the
9 area which would benefit from flood protection provided by the Segale
10 Levee Project, and

11 WHEREAS, the Green River Flood Control Zone District (District)
12 was activated in 1990 to provide a funding source for maintenance of
13 Green River levees and revetments, and

14 WHEREAS, the Segale Levee Project has been the highest rated
15 priority project on the District's annual maintenance priority list
16 for the last two years, and

17 WHEREAS, the Segale Levee Project has historically required
18 maintenance repairs to correct erosive undercutting, levee sloughing
19 and seepage problems, and

20 WHEREAS, large areas of developed property exist within the
21 vicinity of the Segale Levee Project and much of this property could
22 be subject to extensive flooding in the event of a breach at the
23 Segale Levee Project site, and

24 WHEREAS, King County submitted an application for \$815,095 to
25 the Hazard Mitigation Grant Program of the State Department of
26 Community Development (DCD) and the Federal Emergency Management
27 Agency (FEMA) for the Segale Levee Project requesting funds to repair
28 the above-mentioned problems, and

29 WHEREAS, the Segale Levee Project application has been approved
30 for funding by DCD through the grant program and recommended to FEMA
31 for phased funding for the project design costs, and

32 WHEREAS, the 1992 Green River Basin Program Interlocal Agreement
establishes that the District shall be the local sponsor for levee
improvement projects within its boundaries, provided that the


jurisdictions which share flood protection benefits within the project area agree to share costs associated with the local portions of design and construction;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:


