A MOTION authorizing the executive to make a grant application for funds in the approximate amount of \$2,575,889 to support a program entitled Community Heart Action Plan, Grant File No. 928.

WHEREAS, the responsibilities of the emergency medical services division as provided for in the King County Code, Chapter 8.64, include improving emergency medical services, analyzing emergency medical service needs, and providing planning for emergency medical services, and

WHEREAS, over 50% heart attack patients die within one hour on onset of symptoms, and before reaching a medical facility, and

WHEREAS, only 50% of heart attack patients seek assistance by emergency medical services and frequently delay seeking emergency medical assistance, and

WHEREAS, the death and disability due to heart attacks can be reduced by early symptom identification by patients and rapid notification of and treatment by the emergency medical services system, and

WHEREAS, a multifaceted approach which includes educational interventions to the public, patient, and medical care-givers offers an effective, cost-effective means of reducing prehospital delay time by heart attack patients;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

A. The King County executive is hereby authorized to make application for funds in the approximate amount of \$2,575,889 to the National Heart, Lung, and Blood Institute for support of a four-year project to examine the effectiveness of multifaceted community-based interventions in decreasing prehospital delay time by heart attack patients.
