MOTION NO. 9197

A MOTION establishing a local law and justice council in King County pursuant to RCW 72.09.300 and designating the Regional Law, Safety, and Justice Committee as the law and justice council.

WHEREAS, the Regional Law, Safety, and Justice Committee was established in 1989 to share and coordinate criminal justice information and programs, to address important criminal justice issues in the region, and to plan for future criminal justice needs, and

WHEREAS, the Regional Law, Safety, and Justice Committee includes representatives of the criminal justice system from King County, the city of Seattle, and the suburban cities, and reflects a true regional body, and

WHEREAS, the Regional Law, Safety, and Justice Committee played a vital role in demonstrating to the state legislature that additional funding was needed to meet both new mandates from the state and the public's demands for police and other criminal justice services, resulting in the voters approval of Proposition 2, and

WHEREAS, the Regional Law, Safety, and Justice Committee undertook an intensive process to review the causes of the jail population crisis and recommended programs and efficiencies to alleviate jail population crowding, and

WHEREAS, RCW 72.09.300 requires every county legislative authority to establish a local law and justice council and approve a local law and justice plan;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

A. The King County Council hereby establishes the Regional Law, Safety, and Justice Committee as the local law and justice council pursuant to RCW 72.09.300. The County Council ratifies the designation of an Executive Committee of the law and justice council, as specified in Attachment A, to

1 act on behalf of the law and justice council as may be  
2 delegated to it or as required by statute;

3 B. The law and justice council shall submit to the  
4 Council by April 15, 1994 a work program for the development of  
5 the local law and justice plan required by RCW 72.09.300; and


6 C. The law and justice council is hereby authorized to  
7 request technical assistance in developing or implementing the  
8 law and justice plan from other units or agencies of state or  
9 local government, pursuant to RCW 72.09.300.
