MOTION NO. 9210

A MOTION proclaiming the week of January 10 through January 14, 1994, Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Week in King County.

WHEREAS, federal and state legislation has been adopted to recognize Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr.'s birthdate as a national event and holiday, and

WHEREAS, King County government has established a strong tradition in commemorating Dr. King's birthdate, and

WHEREAS, on February 24, 1986, the King County Council set forth the historical basis for redesignating King County in honor of Dr. King, and

WHEREAS, the theme for King County's Seventh Annual Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Celebration is "Building a New Legacy - Upholding the Dream," and comes at a time when King County and Metro employees are working together to build a new regional government, and

WHEREAS, Dr. King was born on January 15, 1929 and lived his life promoting peace, equality and justice for all through nonviolent means, becoming one of the outstanding civil rights leaders of our time;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The week of January 10 - 14, 1994 is proclaimed Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Week in King County. All Metro and King County employees are encouraged to honor Dr. King for his
